Max Tell returning to Tsawwassen Arts Centre to entertain children with new songs

Children's entertainer Max Tell is coming back to Tsawwassen and is bringing some new material with him.

"I'll be presenting songs from my newest CD, to come out later this summer. It's called *Monkey Mumbo Jumbo*," says Tell, noting the disc is geared towards kids from preschool up to Grade 2.

Tell, whose real name is Robert Stelmach, will be performing along with accompanist Chris Kelly at the Tsawwassen Arts Centre next Friday as part of the venue's family series.

They've been working on the new CD together for the past year. Tell is hoping to have the CD out by August or early September since he's heading out on a three-week tour of Brazil later that month.

Tell has been performing since the mid-1980s. He's done shows in Singapore, Australia, Malaysia, Seattle and Ontario and has taken part in events like the Vancouver Children's Festival and the Vancouver Storytelling Festival.
